The Solemnity of the Assumption falls on 15th August. Any major Solemnity that occurs on a Monday or Friday is transferred to the Sunday obligation to ensure maximum celebration.

"the glory of Almighty God who has lavished his special affection upon the Virgin Mary, for the honour of her Son, the immortal King of the Ages and the Victor over sin and death, for the increase of the glory of that same august Mother, and for the joy and exultation of the entire Church; by the authority of our Lord Jesus Christ, of the Blessed Apostles Peter and Paul, and by our own authority, we pronounce, declare, and define it to be a divinely revealed dogma: that the Immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory. *MUNIFICENTISSIMUS DEUS Pp. Pius XII*

The Assumption is the fourth Glorious Mystery of the Rosary. What has been fulfilled in Mary is a promise to what will be fulfilled in us.
